### THE OPPORTUNITY:

We are seeking a Director, Asset Management to build a high performing team to manage our growing portfolio of operating community solar assets in the US and Canada. You will serve as an integral part of the company's growth over the next decade as we scale and place over 500MW of solar and storage into operation. The successful candidate will have experience in building and managing a team that operates multiple assets in regional geographies and be passionate about the coming clean energy transition.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Maximize total returns for each plant; through the analysis of system efficiency and identifying opportunities and initiating actions for improved performance with O&M department; Prepare and review annual budgets, monthly and quarterly performance and regulatory filings
- Own project P&L and work with accounting to ensure proper books and records and financial administration of operating plants including billing and revenue collection, invoice tracking, settlements etc.
- Ensure strict compliance with all project governing documents including Power Purchase Agreements, Hedge Agreements, O&M Agreements, Interconnection Agreements, land leases, Financing Agreements, and LLC Agreements as well as State or ISO/RTO regulations and implementation and management of the above in OYA's cloud platform
- Work collaboratively with internal stakeholders (Finance, Accounting, Development, Power Marketing, Construction, O&M) and manage relationships with external key stakeholders, including but not limited to property owners, PPA offtakers, utilities, ISOs, local and federal governments, permitting and regulatory agencies



- Manage handover process of plants under construction from EPC team to Asset Management and O&M teams including coordination of activities such as commissioning, performance testing, substantial completion, mechanical completion and COD declaration milestones
- Contribute information and analysis to contract negotiations during development, operational improvement initiatives, merger and acquisition activity or legal issues

- Bachelor's degree in engineering or any other technical field. Additional education in finance or accounting preferred
